How To Add Read&Write For Google Chrome Extensions

There are three extensions to add, including Read&Write for Google Chrome, Texthelp PDF Reader, and Screenshot Reader. Once they are all added, they work together, with slightly different toolbars for Google Docs, PDFs in Google Drive/Classroom, and Chrome webpages.

Open the Chrome browser and login to Google using your LCPS login information (for staff and students).

Go to this **Chrome Web Store link** (for LCPS approved extensions and apps).


In the *Search the store* window in the left column, type *read&write*.



In the choices that appear, add the following three extensions, one at a time, by selecting the blue *Add to Chrome* button for each:

Add to Chrome

- Read&Write for Google Chrome
- Texthelp PDF Reader
- Screenshot Reader



(Note: If you've already added the extension, the blue button will display *Rate it* instead of *Add to Chrome*.)

Your Chrome toolbar should now display the three icons for Read&Write for Google Chrome, Texthelp PDF Reader, and Screenshot Reader.
