

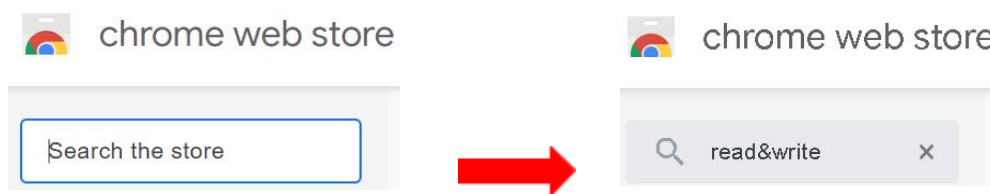
## How To Add Read&Write For Google Chrome Extensions

There are three extensions to add, including Read&Write for Google Chrome, Texthelp PDF Reader, and Screenshot Reader. Once they are all added, they work together, with slightly different toolbars for Google Docs, PDFs in Google Drive/Classroom, and Chrome webpages.

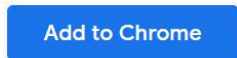
Open the Chrome browser and login to Google using your LCPS login information (for staff and students).

Go to this [Chrome Web Store link](#) (for LCPS approved extensions and apps).

In the *Search the store* window in the left column, type ***read&write***.



In the choices that appear, add the following three extensions, one at a time, by selecting the blue *Add to Chrome* button for each:



- Read&Write for Google Chrome
- Texthelp PDF Reader
- Screenshot Reader
