TumbleBooks are created by taking existing picture books, adding animation, sound, music and narration to produce an electronic picture book which you can read or have read to you.

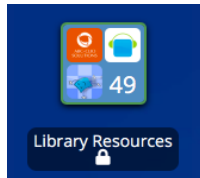
Grades: K-3 (some chapter books for grades 4-5)

The **Index** has a list of all titles. The hyperlinked headings let you sort the list by title, author, or book type.

The speaker symbol next to a title indicates the book is narrated.

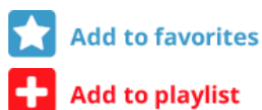
Search



Click on this button at the top right of the screen. It will open a menu to search by title, author, subject, language, theme, genre, or reading level. Some have drop-down choices and some help with auto-fill for spelling.

Click these buttons beneath a book cover to add a book under the Favorites and Playlist tabs.



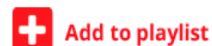
