To avoid plagiarism...

- Include a **BIBLIOGRAPHY** with any project for which you have used print, electronic, or media resources to gather your information.
- If you copy a sentence from a book, put it in “**QUOTATION MARKS**” and cite your source in your bibliography.
- Use images and clipart from **Creative Commons**  sites (these are images that are in the public domain and that you can use for free without the creator’s permission)
- Include citations for images that are not your own (ex. Databases are an easy place to find images, as they include citations).
- Use **Liberty Library’s Bibliography Help Page** and sites like Easybib and Citation Maker when you are creating your bibliography.
- Don’t use more than the following when you are using media in a presentation:
 - 10% or 3 min. of video (whichever is less)
 - 10% or 1000 words of text (whichever is less)
 - 10%, but not greater than 30 seconds of music (whichever is less)
