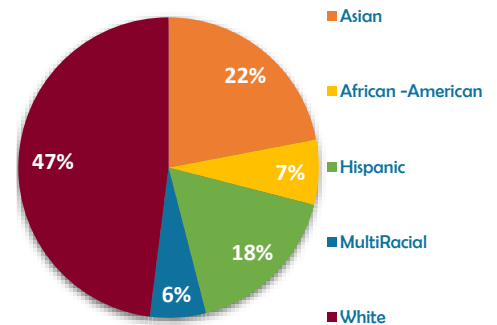

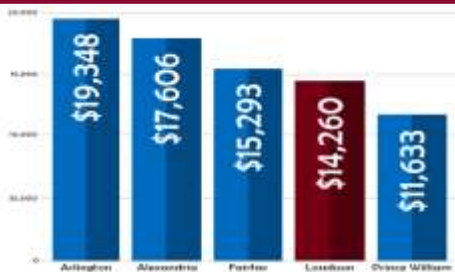

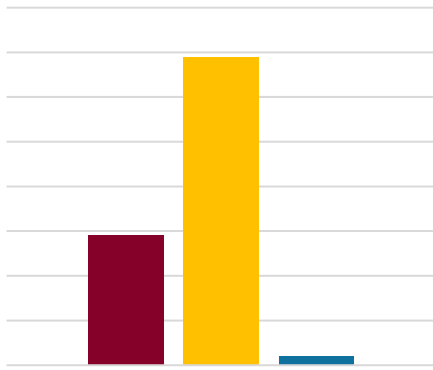

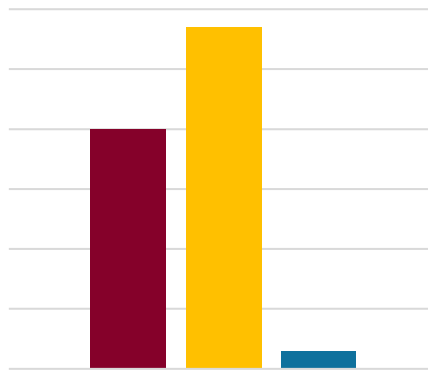

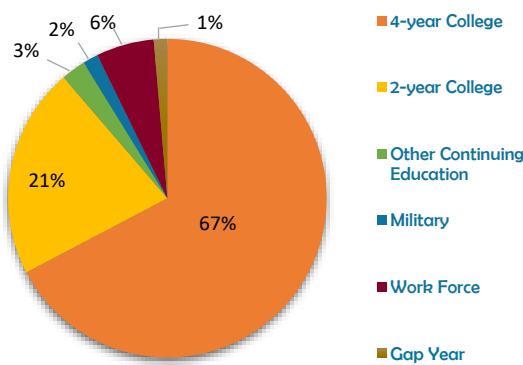

Highlights

- **Dedication to Equity:** LCPS is committed to closing equity gaps and has dedicated resources to accomplishing this goal. Ongoing professional learning on equity is intended to raise the racial literacy of all staff members.
- **School Safety Highlights:** A secure vestibules program to make improvements to access control and visitor screening at each of LCPS' 94 instructional facilities is underway.
- **Individualized Learning Devices:** LCPS is in year two of a three-year rollout that will provide every student in grades three to twelve a laptop in order to support their work on authentic, challenging problems. The technology helps ensure equitable student access to the people, information and tools needed to engage in deeper learning.
- **Deeper Learning:** The LCPS instructional program emphasizes deeper learning through both project-based and personalized learning.

2019 Awards / Recognitions

- 98.8% of Loudoun teachers are identified as highly qualified by VDOE.
- All LCPS schools are fully accredited by the Virginia Department of Education (VDOE) Standards of Learning (SOL) Program.
- All eligible high schools received AdvancED accreditation.
- All eligible middle schools are National Schools to Watch.
- The Academies of Loudoun was the first school in Virginia to receive AdvancED STEM certification.
- LCPS was named a Best-in-State Employer by Forbes Magazine.
