## Code of Virginia 22.1.253.13:4

 This change in the regulations changed the number of diploma types

 The bills (HB1061 and SB 489) eliminated the Modified Standard Diploma, Standard Technical Diploma, Advanced Technical Diploma and the General Achievement Diploma

### Code of Virginia 22.1.253.13:4

- The diploma types described are:
- Standard and Advanced Studies Diploma with one virtual course; Standard Diploma with accommodations for SWD; the guidelines for credit accommodations will be issued by the Board of Education
- ➤ Career and Technical Education within the Standard Diploma
- ➤ Special Diploma



## Modified Standard Diploma

➤ No longer an option for SWD entering 9<sup>th</sup> grade for the first time in 2013-2014

➤ Students enrolled in 9<sup>th</sup> grade prior to 2013-2014 who were seeking a Modified Standard diploma will complete their course of study.



#### **Credit Accommodations**

 Means adjustments to meet the standard and verified credit requirements for earning a Standard Diploma for students with disabilities.

#### **Credit Accommodations**

- May include:
- Approval of alternative courses to meet the standard credit requirements;
- Modifications to the requirements for local school divisions to award locally awarded verified credits
- > Approval of additional tests to earn a verified credit
- Adjusted cut scores required to earn verified credit
- Allowance of work-based learning experiences

### Standard Diploma

- 4 credits in English (2 verified credits)
- 3 credits in Math (1 verified credit)
- 3 credits in Laboratory Science (1 verified credit)
- 3 credits in History and Social Sciences (1 verified credit)
- 2 credits in Health and PE



### Standard Diploma

- 2 credits in Foreign Language, Fine Arts or Career and Technical Education
- 1 credit in Economics and Personal Finance
- 4 Electives
- 1 Student Selected Test (1 verified credit)

Total – 22 credits (6 verified credits required)



### Advanced Studies Diploma

- 4 credits in English (2 verified credits)
- 4 credits in Math (2 verified credits)
- 4 credits in Laboratory Science (2 verified credits)
- 4 credits in History and Social Sciences (2 verified credits)
- 3 credits in a Foreign Language



### Advanced Studies Diploma

- 2 credits in Health and PE
- 1 credit Fine Arts or Career and Technical Education
- 1 credit in Economics and Personal Finance
- 3 Electives
- 1 Student Selected Test (1 verified credit)

Total – 26 credits (9 verified credits required)



## Requirement for Standard and Advanced Studies Diploma

To receive a Standard or Advanced Studies
Diploma, students shall successfully complete
one virtual course, which may be a noncredit bearing course, or may be a course required to
earn the diploma that is offered online.
