Dominion High School Parking Application

Parking facilities are provided at Dominion as a convenience to students in **grades 11 and 12** who drive to school. Parking on school grounds is a privilege that may be granted by the administration. The following conditions must be met if the student wishes to benefit from this privilege:

1. Student must have a valid driver's license and be enrolled in grade 11 or 12.
2. Student will be allowed to register two vehicles.
3. **Student must submit a parking application to obtain a permit. Applications are available online or in the main office.**
4. Student must purchase a parking permit at a cost of **\$200.00**. Cost covers one school year. Payments should be made via the *Online payment Portal*. *If payment by check is necessary, checks can be made payable to Dominion High School.*
5. Student will display parking permit on the rearview mirror and must be visible.
6. Students will park in the student parking lot only.
7. Seniors may submit a separate application to paint a personal parking spot which will be reserved for them during the school day for the entire school year.
8. All other spaces are available on a first come, first serve basis.
9. Once on school grounds, students will not be allowed to leave school or visit their vehicles until dismissed or permission has been obtained from the front office staff.
10. Traffic laws, school regulations, and normal safety procedures must always be obeyed. Maximum speed limit on school grounds is **10 MPH**.
11. Student will keep vehicles locked while parked on school grounds.
12. Vehicles that are improperly parked, blocking fire or driving lanes, or constitute a safety hazard may be tagged, ticketed, booted or towed at the expense of the owner – *this includes those without a properly displayed parking permit*
13. Allowing another student to use your parking permit will result in possible revocation or suspension of parking privileges for all students involved.
14. Violations of any of these guidelines may result in revocation of parking privilege and/or other disciplinary action. All rules and expectations apply when on school property.
15. Lost permits must be replaced at a student cost of \$200.00 if the student wishes to continue to drive to school.
16. The fee will be waived for students that qualify for the free or reduced lunch program. The free and reduced lunch form must be completed by the parent/guardian to document eligibility. Parking application must still be submitted with the waiver form.
