The 2019-2020 Loudoun County Public Schools Annual Student Survey was conducted in February 2020. The online survey was administered at school to students in grades 3-8. Students in grades 9-12 received the Virginia Secondary School Climate Survey, which was mandated for all high schools in the commonwealth. The results of the Virginia high school survey will be published in a separate report.

A total of 31,970 students responded to the LCPS Annual Student Survey, which was based on the 2018-2019 Virginia Student School Climate Survey. Questions addressed student engagement, relationships, academic environment, safety, and social-emotional wellbeing. Several questions asked about the implementation of LCPS instructional initiatives.

This report summarizes the percent of students who responded "Agree" or "Strongly Agree" (middle school) or "Yes" (elementary school) to each statement. Items that were based on percent disagree as the positive response are indicated. For example, the desired response to "Bullying is a problem at this school." is Disagree. The report also compares the school percentages to the results for other LCPS schools of the same type (elementary or middle school). The text for the item statements is from the elementary version of the survey. Middle school students answered the same questions written with more advanced developmentally-appropriate vocabulary.

School and division staff are encouraged to analyze the data in this report to identify strengths and areas for improvement. The perceptions of students should be added to those of parents and staff to provide an overall picture of school climate.
