Number of Respondents: 11,360

The 2020-2021 Loudoun County Public Schools Annual Student Survey was conducted in May/June 2021 to assess indicators of school climate, as well as the implementation of key initiatives. Elementary schools distributed the survey link to their students in grades 3-5. A total of 11,360 valid responses were submitted, representing 62% of students in third through fifth grade in LCPS.

Questions addressed:

- \* Student Engagement, Relationships, and Social-Emotional Wellbeing
- \* LCPS Initiatives and Equitable Practices
- \* Student Behavior and Safety
- \* Bullying
- \* Student-Teacher Relationships, Culturally Responsive Framework, and Academic Environment

This report summarizes the percent of students from each grade level who responded "Yes" to each statement. Items that were based on percent disagree as the positive response are indicated. For example, the desired response to "Bullying is a problem at this school." is No. The report also compares the overall school percentages to the results for other LCPS schools of the same type. Responses are only reported for grade levels in which there were more than 10 respondents.

School staff are encouraged to analyze the data in this report to identify strengths and areas for improvement. The perceptions of students should be added to those of parents and staff to provide an overall picture of school climate.

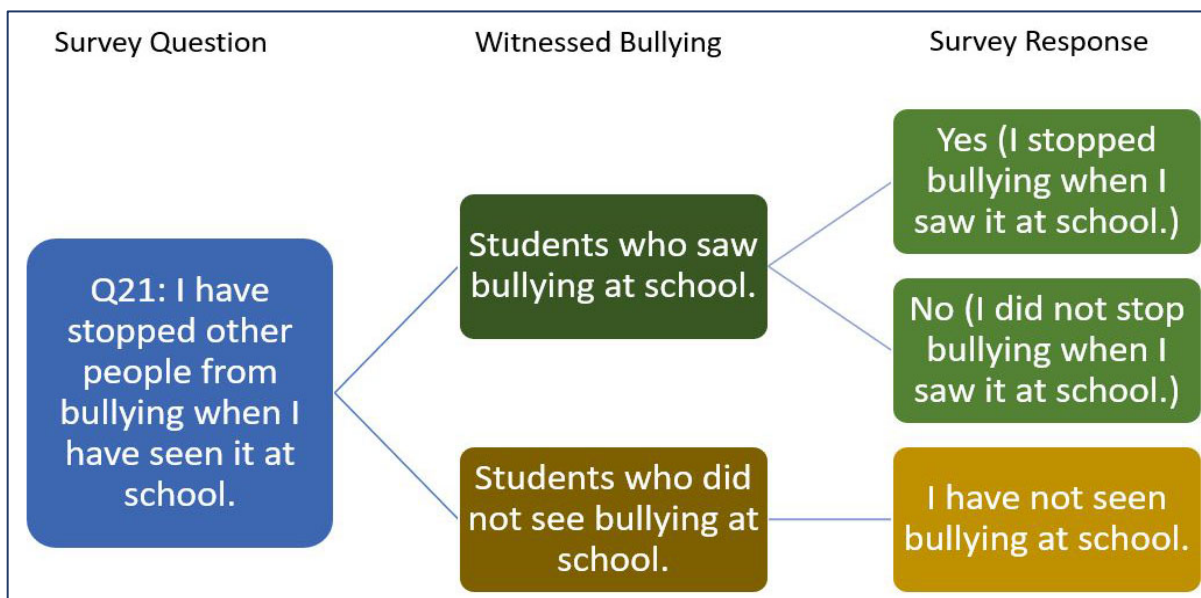
