Number of Respondents: 8,534

The LCPS Annual Secondary Student Survey was conducted in May/June 2021 to assess indicators of school climate, as well as the implementation of key initiatives. High schools distributed the survey link to their students during school hours. Middle schools were excluded from the LCPS Annual Survey because they participated in the Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services Student Survey in 2021. A total of 8,534 valid responses were submitted, representing 32% of high school students in LCPS.

Questions addressed:

- * Student Engagement, Relationships, and Social-Emotional Wellbeing
- * LCPS Initiatives and Equitable Practices
- * Student Behavior and Safety
- * Bullying
- * Student-Teacher Relationships, Culturally Responsive Framework, and Academic Environment

This report summarizes the percent of students from each grade level who responded "Agree" or "Strongly Agree" to each statement. Items that were based on percent disagree as the positive response are indicated. For example, the desired response to "Bullying is a problem at this school." is Disagree. The report also compares the overall school percentages to the results for other LCPS schools of the same type. Responses are only reported for grade levels in which there were more than 10 respondents.

School staff are encouraged to analyze the data in this report to identify strengths and areas for improvement. The perceptions of students should be added to those of parents and staff to provide an overall picture of school climate.

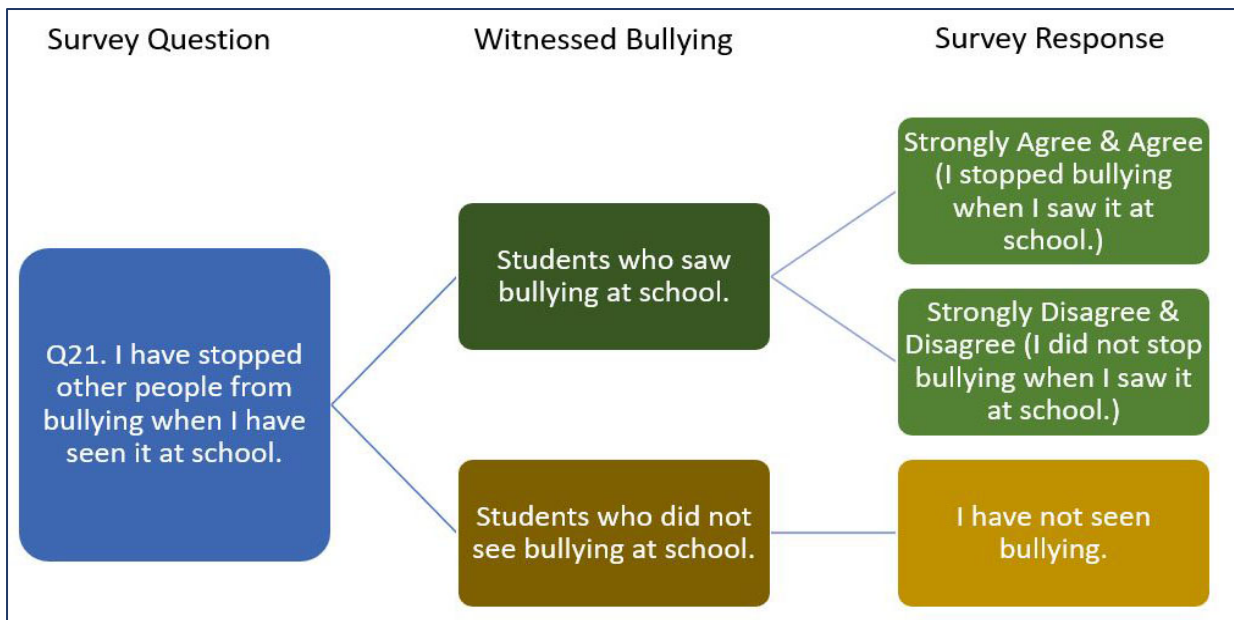
