StudentVUE Getting Started with StudentVUE

StudentVUE provides secure, private access to your school information, including assignments, grades, attendance, school calendar and teacher contact information.

Grades 2-12: to use StudentVUE you must first log into an LCPS computer and change your password.

ACTIVATE MY ACCOUNT – GRADES 2-12

- Log into an LCPS computer using your student ID and default password (or use <u>LCPSGO</u> on any device).
- 2. Follow the prompts to change your password.
- You will now be able to log into your StudentVUE
 account from any internet enabled computer (or from
 the StudentVUE app).

LOG IN

- 1. In your web browser go to https://portal.lcps.org.
- 2. Click on I am a student>>.



3. Enter your user name and password and click on Login.



4. Navigate through **StudentVUE** using the menu items on the right side of the screen.

RESET MY PASSWORD – SECONDARY ONLY

- Secondary students are required to change passwords every 180 days. Elementary students do not need to change passwords.
- 2. Log into an LCPS computer using your user name and current password (or use LCPSGO on any device).
- 3. Press CTRL-ALT-DELETE.
- 4. Click on Change a password...
- 5. Follow the prompts to create a new password.

Note: if you have forgotten your password, contact the IFT or Technology Assistant at your school.

MOBILE APPS

Download the StudentVUE app from the iTunes store. Search for **StudentVUE**.

- Requires iOS 9.0 or later.
- Compatible with iPhone, iPad, and iPod touch.
- Configure the app with the same URL https://portal.lcps.org
 as the web application.

- Compatible with phones and tablets running Android 4.1 or later.
- Configure the app with the same URL https://portal.lcps.org
 as the web application.

STUDENTVUE NAVIGATION

StudentVUE is driven by the menu items on the left side of the screen. Click on an item in the **StudentVUE Navigation Menu** to view your information on that topic.



Messages: View district and school-based messages.

Calendar: View daily class information such as homework, quizzes and projects. Filter information using the drop-down arrows at the top of the screen.

Attendance: View attendance information.

Class Schedule: View your class schedule and teachers. Click on a teacher's name to send an email.

Class Websites: View content and links your teachers have posted for class resources.

Course History: View transcript information as well as graduation requirements.

Grade Book: View individual assignments and grading information. Click on a class to view specific assignments.

Health: View immunization records.

Report Card: View grades for specific marking periods in the current school year.

School Information: View contact information for your teachers.

Student Info: View your demographic information on file with the school district.

Test History: View history of standardized test scores.

Documents: View historical student documents like SOL results and Year-End Report Cards.
