- Abuse of authority or using position for gain.
- Theft or misuse of school funds or property.
- Corruption and bribery.
- Receiving kickbacks.
- Records falsification (such as personnel, time and attendance or procurement).



The “My Concern Is” Hotline is **571-252-2488**. The Hotline is available 24/7 and provides a convenient and anonymous means for employees to report suspected instances of fraud, misuse of Loudoun County Public School property and unethical conduct, as well as other workplace concerns.

Confidentiality and Privacy

It is OAG practice to not disclose the identity of individuals submitting a complaint or information to the Hotline unless the individual consents to such disclosure, or unless the OAG determines that such disclosure is unavoidable in the course of an investigation. Please keep in mind, if you choose to file anonymously OAG will be unable to request additional information from you and may be unable to investigate your complaint effectively.
