

## Stone Hill Middle Supply List 2016-17

Stone Hill Middle School is a “Bring Your Own Technology” school. (BYOT) Technology devices will become more of a tool for our students as we move toward more project based learning, and other strategies which encourage critical thinking, problem solving and collaboration.

In addition to a list of basic school supplies found below, students are encouraged to bring a device to school for classroom use. A device which has internet access, possibly includes word processing capability, and enables the student to access Google Classroom, conduct research, maintain notes and has a protective case would be ideal. Some ideas include Chromebooks, Lenovo Laptops or Tablets, or any other small laptop type device. We will work with Smartphones, but the smaller screens are not always practical.

Bringing a device to school is optional; the school will have devices available for students to use if they don't have their own at school.
