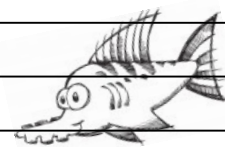
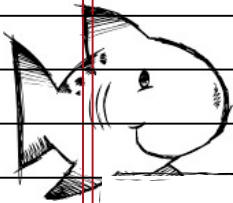

This is Einstein's Riddle:

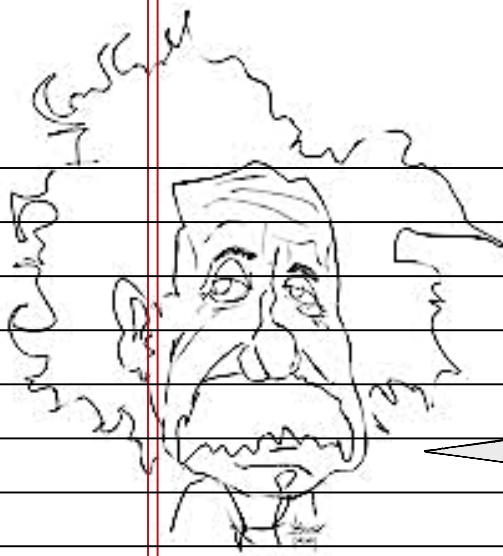

DON'T FREAK OUT! HERE IS A LITTLE HELP!!!

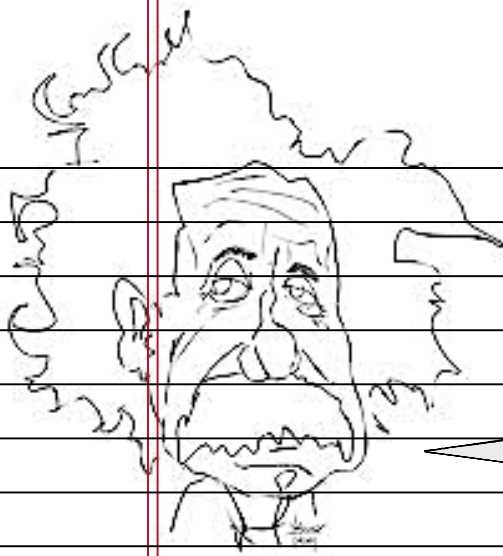
1. The British man lives in the red house.
