Treasurer's Report

- PTA has \$13,595.12 in cash in the accounts.
- Linda presented the proposed Annual Budget for 2021-2022. The group reviewed and discussed each line item. Below are some if the discussion points for budget adjustment consideration:
 - o Income was down this year, as to be expected with the pandemic year.
 - o Most of the budget amounts are the same year over year.
 - o Planned income for next year \$12,680
 - The staff volleyball event may be removed from the budget which impacts income (\$1,600).
 - AmazonSmile rewards doubled YOY totaling \$240 need to keep FSMS families using this option for shopping.
 - Suzanne expressed concern around the School Supply budget. To reach we'd need to sell 350 kits and that may not be feasible. Last year we grossed \$440.
 Reduced to \$850 of income.
 - o Planned Expenses for next year \$12,679
 - Ms. Loya suggested that we remove \$850 from expenses by removing the Volunteer Appreciation events to help do that.
 - Suzanne questioned the hospitality budget covers Luncheon and Staff Appreciation week and the rest is parent donations (Baked goods, etc.).
 - PTA conference is free for officers to attend. Remove from budget.

After reviewing the budget and making the noted updates, Linda made a motion to approve the 2021-2022 budget, Nichole Keller seconded and all approved.

Principal's Report - Sherryl Loya

- Conducted a great awards ceremony for the 8th graders today, 6/1.
- 8th grade students will come in Monday, June 7th from 1-3PM to get their awards/goodie bags/yearbooks, pictures with their teachers, etc.
- Everyone is looking forward to the fall and having everyone back 5 days a week.
- Friday August 20 will be a good day for PTA spirit wear sales and PTA membership drive as that will be the parent back to school events.

- Ms. Loya recommends during parent nights a book for Middle School Parents. She recommends reading *Middle Makeover* by Michele Icard. She said she will add this back into her orientation presentation.

 - o Since students will not have lockers next year, the list of supplies is less.
 - o Amy will send out an email this week with information as well as Ashburn, Dominion and Discovery Elementary for awareness.
 - o The supply costs are 6^{th} \$49, 7^{th} \$48, and 8^{th} \$52.
 - o Orders are open through July 5th.
 - o Orders will ship to students' homes by August 18th.
