

Central Loudoun Little League Scholarship – 4 @ \$500 (one for each high school)

CLLL's annual scholarship was developed in 2012 with the intent of recognizing one individual from each of the high schools within our boundaries, (**Heritage**, Loudoun County High School, Riverside and Tuscarora High School), who have demonstrated a commitment to baseball, our community and continuing his or her education.

- Criteria:** Applicant must have been a player participant or youth umpire in Central Loudoun Little League
Applicant must be in the graduating class of 2018
Applicant plans to enroll in an accredited community college, trade school, college or university as a full-time or part-time student
The scholarship is payable to the educational institution directly upon proof of enrollment
Applicant must submit a **minimum** one page, double-spaced essay detailing the impact that their experience in CLLL has had on their lives. Essay must include the years of participation in the league
- Selection:** Selection of the scholarship recipient will be made by the CLLL Board of Directors
Please note that CLLL reserves the right not to award the scholarship if we do not receive suitable applications
