ASHBURN, Va. - Loudoun County Public Schools (LCPS) will offer tutoring in reading and math services for selected students in grades 3 through 8 through the Virginia Department of Education's [All In VA](#) plan.

Starting in January, each elementary and middle school in LCPS will communicate individually with families of students in grades 3 through 8 who qualify for these tutoring services. Details regarding how and when tutoring is delivered also will be shared. Tutoring will begin by January 23, 2024.

The tutoring services plan follows Governor Youngkin's September 7, 2023 announcement of the ALL in VA plan. The plan provides funding to combat chronic absenteeism, address learning gaps in reading and math for grades 3 through 8 students and accelerate the expansion of the Virginia Literacy Act (VLA).

The Loudoun County School Board approved the Division's ALL in VA spending plan on Tuesday, November 15. Of the \$13,622,240 allocated to LCPS, \$9.6 million (70 percent) will go toward high-dosage tutoring. Of the remaining funds, \$2.73 million (20 percent) will be devoted to literacy initiatives and \$1.36 million (10 percent) will go toward combating chronic absenteeism.

This high-dosage tutoring does not replace LCPS' current structure for providing support and remediation to address individual student needs. Additionally, all students, regardless of whether they have been identified to receive tutoring services or not, will have access to free online services.
