Work Session: Loudoun County Public Schools – Capital Facilities Needs

Assistant Superintendent for Support Services **Kevin Lewis** and Director, Planning Services **Beverly Tate**, along with Loudoun County Deputy Director of Planning & Zoning **Alaina Ray**, Deputy County Administrator **Charles Yudd** and Director of Management & Budget **Erin McLellan** presented an overview of future school and land acquisition needs for Loudoun County Public Schools, based on Loudoun County's current *Revised General Plan* (RGP) buildout and potential impact of the draft *Loudoun 2040 Comprehensive Plan*.
