Support Services: Assistant Superintendent for Support Services **Kevin Lewis** presented the Preliminary 2018-2019 Enrollment Report. As of Thursday, September 6, 2018, enrollment for the 2018-2019 school year was 82,051 students - 98.7 percent of the projected 83,105 student enrollment for September 28, 2018. Lewis also presented a school name recommendation; that the former Monroe Technology Center be renamed as the Charles S. Monroe Education Center.
