Minutes; Charter School Committee: Motion to Reconsider School Board Approval of County Recycling Centers at Hillsboro Charter Academy (HCA) and Park View High School (PVHS); Pupil Services: Exemption from School Attendance for Religious Reasons; and Licensed and Classified Personnel Actions, including the following administrative appointment and resignation:

Michael Pellegrino as the first principal of Waxpool Elementary. Mr. Pellegrino holds a bachelor's degree in elementary education from East Stroudsburg University and a master's degree in education from Shenandoah University. He has served as a third and fifth grade teacher at Cool Spring Elementary; as an assistant principal at Ball's Bluff Elementary and Meadowland Elementary; as principal of Lucketts Elementary; and as principal of Evergreen Mill Elementary.

Angela Robinson resigned as principal of Leesburg Elementary, effective November 16. Ms. Robinson holds a bachelor's degree in early childhood education from and a master's degree in administration/supervision from George Mason University. She has served as a teacher at Layton Hall and Kings Park elementary schools for Fairfax County Public Schools; as an assistant principal at Park Ridge Elementary School in Stafford County Public Schools; as an assistant principal of Providence Elementary in Fairfax County Public Schools; and as principal of Cool Spring, Sugarland and Leesburg elementary schools.
